APPLICATION DEADLINES:First Application Period:

- All forms must be postmarked, Faxed (245-2791), or received by **January 29, 2010**.

Second Application Period:

- All forms must be postmarked, faxed, or received by **February 26, 2010**.

Open Application Period:

- Applications will continue to be accepted after the second application period. Students who apply after February 26, 2010, will automatically be placed on a waiting list after students who were drawn during the lottery. Placement on this list is by the date the completed application is received.

If the number of applications exceeds the available spaces in one or more grades, attendance, except for existing pupils of the school and students with preferences shall be determined by a public, random drawing of all prospective students who have completed the application process. The Lottery process is explained in detail in the charter.

**Applications received during the First Application Period
(December 1- January 29) are in the first draw.**

Parents may apply for admission for their students for 2010-2011 any time after December 1, 2009. Admission is determined by admission policies (above).

Lottery Process

All applicants who are exercising a preference (sibling of current student, children of U-Prep faculty) must submit their applications by January 29, 2010. Sibling preferences may not be exercised by student applicants who have previously attended U-prep and subsequently transferred to another school.

All other qualified applicants who submit a completed application by January 29, 2010, are considered to be in the First Draw.

First Draw

Current students, who meet the academic, attendance, and behavior standards of the U-prep charter and who have indicated that they are returning to U-Prep, keep their status as enrolled students. Applicants, who have preferences and have applied by January 29, 2010, are next to be enrolled. The remaining spaces are open to lottery. If the remaining spaces can accommodate all of the first draw applicants, they will be admitted on February 1, 2010. If First Draw applicants exceeded the number of available spaces, they are drawn before students who applied after the First Draw deadline (January 29, 2010).

Second Draw

All applicants not accepted by February 1, 2010, are drawn randomly and assigned a number. If First Draw applicants exceeded the number of available spaces, they are drawn before students who applied after the First Draw deadline (January 29, 2010). All Second Draw applicants are then drawn and assigned a number. Students who are not enrolled are put on a waiting list based on their number; they will be called as spaces open. When notified about an available space, parents have one week to respond; if no response is received the space will be forfeited and the student placed on the bottom of the Waiting List.

- The decision to readmit a pupil or admit a previously expelled pupil from another school, school district or Charter School shall be in the sole discretion of the Governing Board following a meeting with the Superintendent/Principal and the pupil and guardian or representative to determine whether the pupil has successfully completed the rehabilitation plan and to determine whether the pupil poses a threat to others or will be disruptive to the school environment. The Superintendent/Principal shall make a recommendation to the Governing Board following the meeting regarding his or her determination. The pupil's admission is also contingent upon University Preparatory School's capacity at the time the student seeks admission.
