1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded.

U-Prep was granted a waiver from the California Department of Education (CDE), allowing Proposition 28 funds to be allocated differently than prescribed in statute. Funds were expended in accordance with the approved waiver and as originally planned.

Funds were used to enhance the quality of arts education through:

- **Course Offerings:** Staffing of our new Junior High Drama Course in 2025-2026
- **Materials and Supplies:** Purchase of art supplies, musical instruments, theater props, dance equipment, and digital art tools and software.
- **Equipment:** Acquisition of audio-visual equipment, innovative technology for arts education, and curriculum resources supporting digital arts and computer science/drafting courses.
- **Program Enhancements:** Expansion of student learning opportunities through that provided experiences in costume and set design, video production, and other arts-related disciplines.
- **Arts Exploration:** Support for student participation in community arts activities, including camps, clinics, workshops, field trips, and performances.
- **Professional Development:** Professional learning opportunities for staff to strengthen and expand arts education programming
