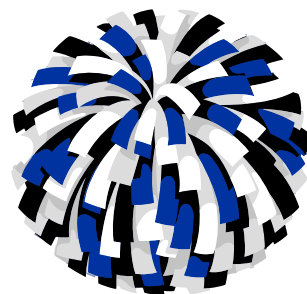

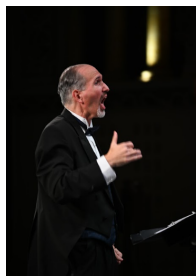


Cookies and Cram

HS Athletics

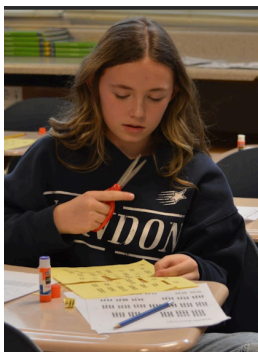
